The Consumer-Patient Radiation Health and Safety Act is federal law that requires that all persons who use x-rays to take dental images must be properly trained and certified. All students must refrain from engaging the exposure button until licensed. Students you are required to have a total 24 hours of Internship/Externship performing the following:

- Demonstrate measures used to protect the patient and operator from exposure
- Describe uses of dental imaging
- Demonstrate proper use and maintenance of the Dental X-ray Machine
- Perform infection control practices required for all dental imaging technique
- Scanning and/or processing of dental radiographs
- Demonstrate paralleling and bisecting technique by using XCPs
- Mounting and labeling of full mouth series (FMX) and position patient for a panoramic procedure
